Did you know that the Notifications feature in your ILLiad account displays the 20 most recent emails sent to you? The Notifications page displays the email subject and date. Clicking on the subject link displays the details of the selected email. The Notifications page shows in addition to the emails and is an additional reminder to the user, not a replacement to the original email.
